6. Primary Health Care

Focus on preventive health care and initiate integrated health programs. Tackle five preventable diseases: acute respiratory illness, TB, measles, malaria and malnutrition.

7. Drinking water and Sanitation

Encourage the community to protection of environment, access to safe drinking water, promote ceramic filters, create awareness on safe drinking water and sanitation.

8. Food Security:

Introduce adaptable agriculture technology and technique, strengthen farmer's knowledge in natural resource management and conservation.

9. Basic Education:

Initiate school partnership program to strengthen the capacity of teachers and school management committee. Promote non formal education, arrange scholarship for drop out and deserving children.

10. Integral Mission

Enable Church leaders to address the social issues, encourage churches to initiate congregation based holistic development projects. Associate with Micah network for integral mission.

11. HIV/AIDS

Launch HIV/AIDS awareness campaign and facilitate rehabilitation of HIV/AIDS infected and affected persons. Integrating HIV/AIDS issues in each program.

12. Capacity strengthening of NGO's, CBO's and Church organizations

Establish a learning centre as a common platform. Strengthen the governance, project management and implementation capacity of organisations.

13. Women's empowerment

Promote rights of women, raise issues on gender inequality, provide learning opportunity and uplifting the economic status of women.

14. Disaster mitigation and management:

Provide emergency relief, form disaster mitigation committees and integrate disaster response in ongoing programs. Conduct disaster preparedness training.

15. Research

Initiate research on psychological impact of conflict on the community with special reference to women and children, issues of sustainability and community partnership.

The Foremost Priorities

1. Rehabilitation of Conflict affected People

3. Capacity Strengthening in Local Governance

Provide opportunities to elected local political leaders to enhance their governance skills. Conduct seminars in management and planning of local self government.

4. Advocacy and influencing Policies.

Do advocacy for the voiceless communities, build community awareness, network for joint lobbying and influencing policies.

5. Poverty Reduction

Generate employment opportunities, provide vocational training and campaign in support of the millennium development goals.
